



NGEL Inks MoUs with Port Authorities & SCI during Global Maritime India Summit



NGEL has executed MoUs with Port Authorities (Kolkata, Tutikorin and Kandla) and the Shipping Corp of India Ltd (SCI) during the three-day Global Maritime India Summit held at Mumbai. The summit was inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister on 17th Oct'23 via video-conferencing.

The MoU exchanged with Shyama Prasad Mookerjee Port (SPMP), Kolkata aims for development of Green Hydrogen Hub on the land owned by the Port Authority near the Haldia Port.

Other MoUs were signed with Chidambaranar Port Authority (VOCPA), Tutikorin, and Deendayal Port Authority (DPA), Kandla shall be useful for development of Green Hydrogen Hub on the portland and supply of green fuels for captive use of SCI.

The MoUs were signed in the presence of Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra, Hon'ble Chief Ministers of Maharashtra and Goa, Hon'ble Union Minister of Ports, Shipping and Waterways and Hon'ble Minister of State for Ports, Shipping and Waterways besides dignitaries from NGEL, SCI and Port Authorities.
