



NGEL Inks MoUs with GSPC and GPPL during Vibrant Gujarat Global Summit



NGEL has executed MoUs with Gujarat State Petroleum Corporation Ltd. (GSPC) and Gujarat Pipavav Port Ltd. (GPPL) during the three-day Vibrant Gujarat Global Summit held at Gandhinagar. The summit was inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister on 10th Jan '24.

The MoU with GSPC exchanged between Shri Gurdeep Singh, CMD, NTPC and Shri Milind Torawane, MD, GSPC in the presence of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Gujarat, Hon'ble Minister of Finance, Energy & Petrochemicals, GoG, Dr V K Saraswat, Member, NITI Aayog, other senior officials and international delegates. The MoU aims for the blending of Green Hydrogen in the gas networks of GSPC and Green Hydrogen mobility by setting up of Green Hydrogen fuelling stations in Gujarat.

Other MoU with GPPL exchanged between Shri DMR Panda, GM (Hydrogen), NTPC and Shri Girish Aggarwal, MD of APM Terminals, Pipavav aims to develop Green Hydrogen ecosystem including production of Green Ammonia at the land provided by GPPL for Export and domestic market. It also aims to explore Pipavav Port as an anchor port by NGEL for exploration, development, and operations of offshore wind farms in Gujarat.
